

WHAT TO EXPECT

Are you registered?

Check whether you are registered to vote. Review instructions & guidelines for eligibility to voter and how to register. Request voter registration forms. Registration Status, Instructions, and voting forms click this link <u>http://votetexas.gov/.</u>

<u>Please note that you must already be a registered voter 30 days before election day</u> to be eligible to vote.

What to Expect.

Bowie County utilizes the Election System and Software system in all its polling locations. You will need to present an approved form of ID. You will be provided a voting activation card (paper ballot) that is specific to what you are eligible to vote for. You will choose from a slate of candidates, review your ballot after you have selected your favorite, and then deposit your ballot in the tabulator. Where to Vote

If you are voting in person during the **Early Voting** period, you may vote at any early voting polling location.

If you are voting on **Election Day**, you may vote at any of the 22 convenient Voting Centers.

Identification

When you arrive, you will be asked for identification. Valid forms of ID include:

- Voter ID Card
- Valid Texas Driver's License
- Passport

Voting Booth
