ABSENTEE VOTING

Absentee Voting (Ballot by Mail)

A voter who is over 65, out of the county during early voting or election day, disabled or confined in jail who prefers to vote by mail may request an absentee ballot from the Bowie County Elections Administration Office.

Please note to receive an absentee ballot you must submit an application for ballot by mail. Application procedures are listed below.

An absentee ballot request must be submitted and be received by the Elections Administrator no later than 11 days prior to the election. An individual application or letter is needed for each person requesting an absentee ballot. The application **must include** name, address where the person is registered, address where to send the ballot, reason for voting by mail, political party (for primary elections) and signature.

NOTE If you fax or email your Absentee application (vote by mail) form, please be aware that you must also MAIL the form to the early voting clerk within four business days. Your application will not be processed until mailed original is received timely.

Military & Civilians Overseas

Military and spouse or dependents of military and civilians overseas will need to get an <u>FPCA application (PDF)</u>. This application is good for 1 calendar year. A blank application and more information can be obtained from the federal government at <u>www.fvap.gov</u> or <u>www.overseasvotefoundation.org</u>.

Your Absentee Ballot must be received by the Bowie County Early Voting Clerk before the close of the polls at 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.

NOTE If you fax your FPCA application, please be aware that you must also MAIL the form to the early voting clerk within four business days. Your application will not be process until mailed original is received timely.
