The District Clerk, Deputy Clerks, the Court Coordinators and the Judges' Secretary are prohibited from giving advice, answering legal questions or giving instructions with regard to divorce or any other Court proceedings. They cannot answer questions you may have about correctness of papers you wish to file or procedures to obtain a Court decision.

Instructions or information you may have read or obtained may not be correct. Directives in divorce "kits" are not binding on the Clerk and documents are not processed in accordance with any rules or instructions other than the governing laws of the State of Texas.

For the above reasons, we advise you to consult an attorney or seek legal counsel if you have any questions or are unsure as to what you need to do.
