**ORDER TERMINATING BANNING OPEN FIRES
PROHIBITION OF OUTDOOR BURNING ORDER**

WHEREAS, the Bowie County Judge found on December 29, 2025, that circumstances presented in all or part of the unincorporated area of Bowie County creating a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning and therefore signed a Declaration of Disaster and Banning Open Fires Prohibition of Outdoor Burning that prohibited outdoor burning and, further extended the Declaration of Disaster and Banning Open Fires Prohibition of Outdoor Burning on January 5, 2026, due to no change in conditions in all or part of the unincorporated areas of Bowie County until such time as the County Judge determined conditions no longer created a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning;

WHEREAS; the County Judge has determined that circumstances present in all or part of the unincorporated areas of Bowie County no longer create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning and has met the standards pursuant to Local Government Code 352.081, and other applicable statutes;


NOW THEREFORE, it is **ORDERED**, by the Bowie County Judge, that the Declaration of Disaster and Banning Open Fires Prohibition of Outdoor Burning issued on December 29, 2025 and extended on January 5, 2026, is hereby terminated effective 11:35 a.m. on January 21, 2026.
