
Call to Order.

Comments must be pertinent to an agenda item or an area for which the Court has jurisdiction. The total allocated time is 30 minutes for all comments.

3. Consider and take action to approve a Resolution in Support of the Sheriff Immigration Law Enforcement Grant Program-Senate Bill 8 Application.
4. Consider and take action to declare surplus fixed assets #3496 Cat Motor Grader M9D00668 and #3497 Cat Motor Grader M9D00671 to be traded in on the purchase of new equipment for Precinct 3.


